In relation to constituencies the potential for fixed constituency boundaries (ie to say a county) and adjust the number of TDs for the population – I am aware geography is factored in currently but in this case it would take precedence over population figures Looking at larger constituency sizes ie up to 9 as was previous done. Also if there would be a benefit in having a higher minimum number of TDs per constituency ie having a 4 or 5 seater as the smallest possible as they lead to more proportional outcomes n a PRSTV system Capping the number of TDs in the Dail at a fixed number and adjusting constituencies based on that

The potential to elect some TDs on a list system rather then having all TDs elected from constituencies and the positives and negatives of that

The potential for a centralised electoral register to be held by the electoral commission as opposed to local authorities

The potential to move administration/management/running of of elections from the Department of Housing to the Electoral Commission
